Reporting to:	CEO				
Organisation purpose:	We Belong exists to ensure young migrants living in the UK are treated equally and fairly in the society they call home. We Belong works with and for young migrants to hold those in power to account and fight for wider reform.				
	We do this by breaking down barriers through direct advocacy, strategic campaigning, equipping young migrants to be leaders and setting agendas within the migration sector. We also provide support by giving accurate information on student finance rules, providing various opportunities and make referrals to organisations for young people to get the legal advice they need.				
Context	We Belong works exclusively with young people who have migrated to the UK and are impacted by hostile immigration policies. We support and enable these young people to challenge these policies themselves.  We Belong will be opening a branch in Manchester, partnering with The University of Manchester to develop relationships with schools in the city. We will work closely with student volunteers to identify young migrants with support needs and develop a programme of support to improve individual outcomes.				
Role purpose:	The Outreach Officer will provide quality support for young migrants who have migrated to the UK and are seeking help in accessing higher education. They will develop a core community of young change agents by working closely with educational institutions and community groups. The Outreach Officer will develop a programme of activity to engage young migrants from diverse communities, build campaigns and develop young people with lived experience.  This role requires supporting and regularly checking in on young people who are affiliated with We Belong in the Manchester area; providing a non-judgmental				
.,	environment in which migrants are able to speak freely about the issues that affect them. The Outreach Officer will provide accurate information for those who need it engage young people in various We Belong activities.
